- The Medical Center has three degree-granting institutions: <u>UT Southwestern Medical</u>
 <u>School</u>, <u>UT Southwestern Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences</u>, and <u>UT Southwestern School of Health Professions</u>. The schools train about 3,700 medical, graduate, and allied health students, residents, and postdoctoral fellows each year.

- UT Southwestern has approximately 18,800 employees and an operating budget of \$4.1 billion.



- Federal highway programs: \$26.9 billion
- Public Transportation: \$3.3 billion
- **Drinking water infrastructure (and removing lead pipes):** \$2.9 billion
- *Airports:* \$1.2 billion
- Bridge replacement and repairs: \$537 million
- *Electric vehicle charging network:* \$408 million
- Broadband expansion: \$100 million
- Wildfire protection: \$53 million
- Cyberattacks protection: \$42 million
