





## City of Dallas Fair Park Community Park

The Community Park is the new signature park at Fair Park, adjacent to Dos Equis Pavilion within the current extents of 10A-10B parking lots. On an 11-acre site, the new park will include Multi-purpose pavilions, Children's playgrounds, Outside fitness areas, Dog park, Amphitheatre + Civic Lawn, Water Play features, Orchards + native gardens intended to be open and accessible to all visitors of the park 365 days of the year. This will also include locations for a Pavilion Café, future kitchen expansion, additional parking spaces and a small area for auxiliary Fair Park Community Park offices.

## Science Building


Tyler, TX

This approximately 120,000 GSF building will provide flexible, state-of-theart labs for research and teaching with the associated instrumentation, prep, and write-up spaces.

Other programmatic functions will include offices and conference rooms to support the future growth of faculty and graduate students, dedicated student success areas with commons, huddle spaces, and open study locations, and a shared chemical suite with stock and dispensing rooms to serve the entire building.



### DFW International Airport International Parkway Project

The project scope for the DFW Airport International Parkway project includes the construction of a new 4.2-mile, six-lane toll road connecting State Highway 114 to DFW Airport, two new flyover bridges over SH 114 and DFW Connector, and a new toll plaza and associated facilities. Demolition of the existing International Parkway, and new environmental mitigation measures, including the construction of a new wildlife crossing. The total cost of the project is estimated to be \$250 million. The new toll road will improve access to the airport and help to reduce traffic congestion in the area.
