Infrastructure Bill Opportunities Impact on Texas with a Focus on North Texas

- Federal highway programs: \$26.9 billion
- *Public Transportation:* \$3.3 billion
- Drinking water infrastructure (and removing lead pipes): \$2.9 billion
- *Airports:* \$1.2 billion
- Bridge replacement and repairs: \$537 million
- *Electric vehicle charging network:* \$408 million
- Broadband expansion: \$100 million
- *Wildfire protection:* \$53 million
- *Cyberattacks protection:* \$42 million
