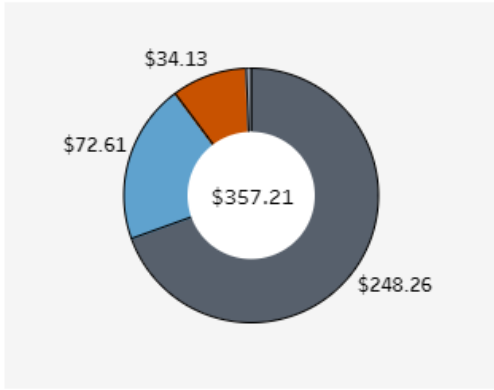

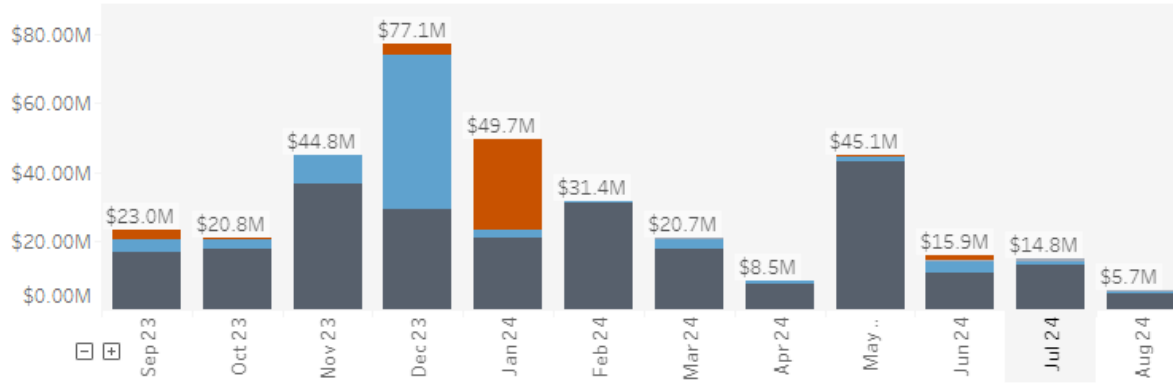
Austin Letting Information By Fiscal Year (September to August)



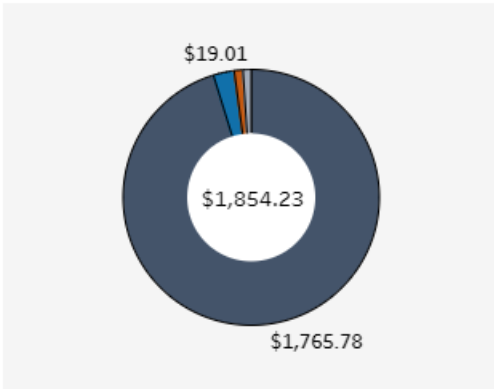
FY 2024 Letting Amount (\$) by Let Type



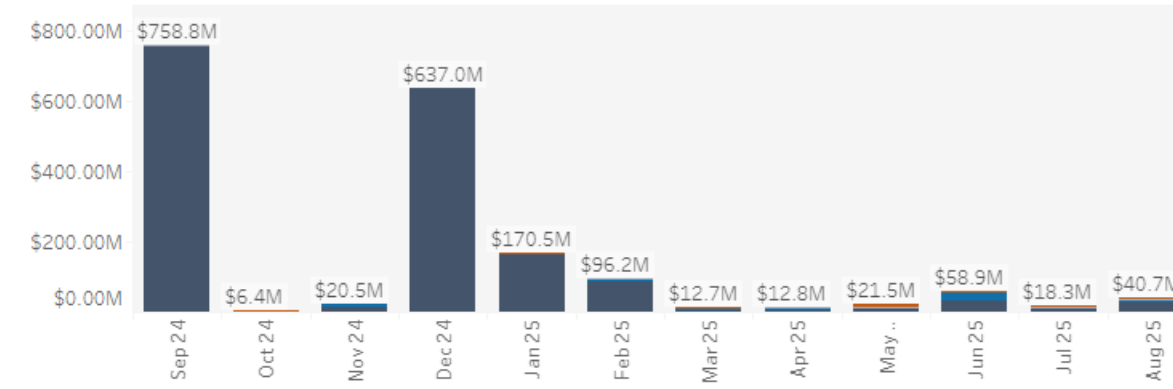
FY 2024 Letting Amount by Month

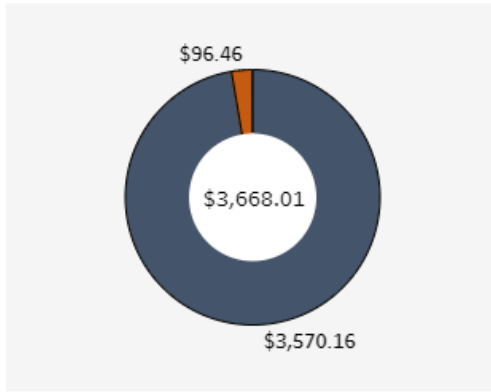

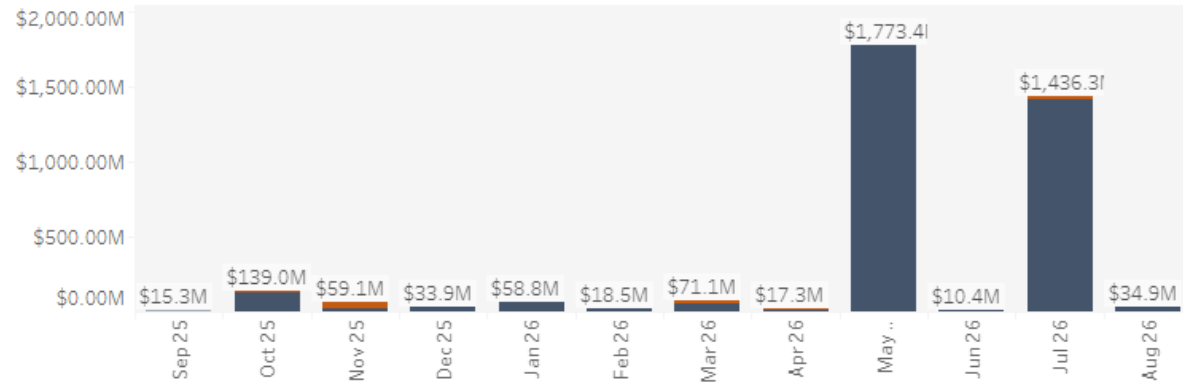

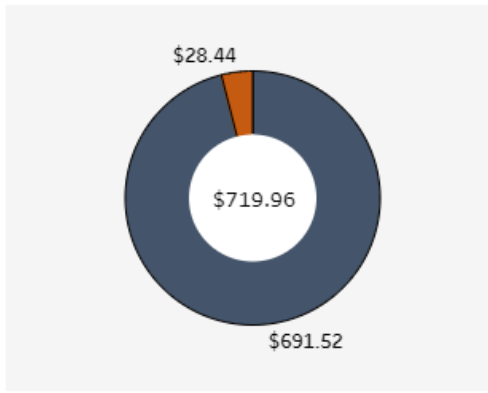
FY 2026 Letting Amount (\$) by Let Type



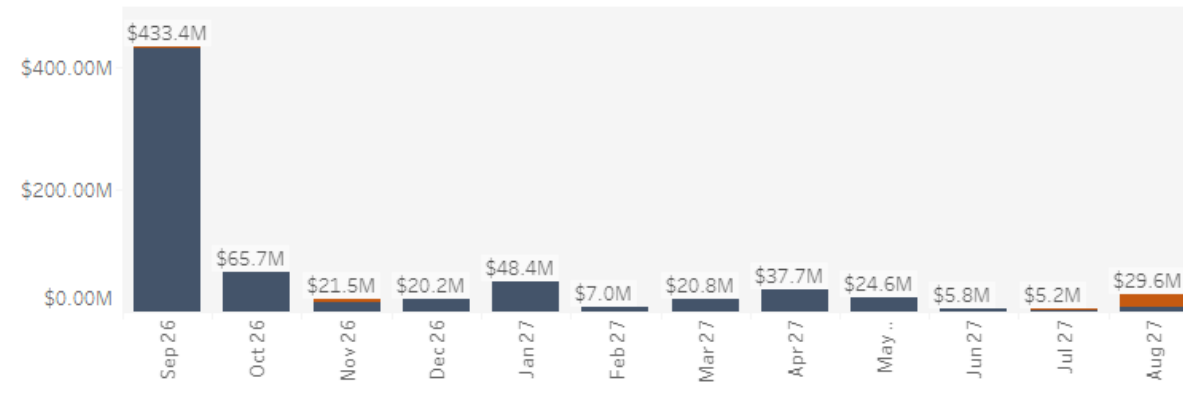
FY 2026 Letting Amount by Month

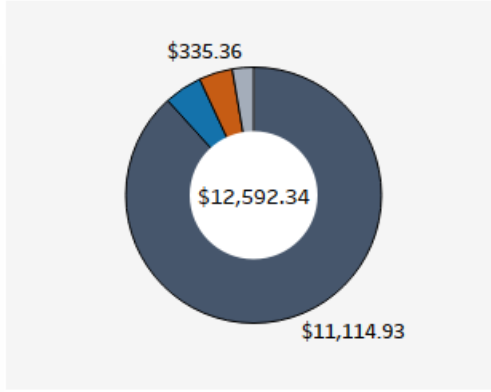

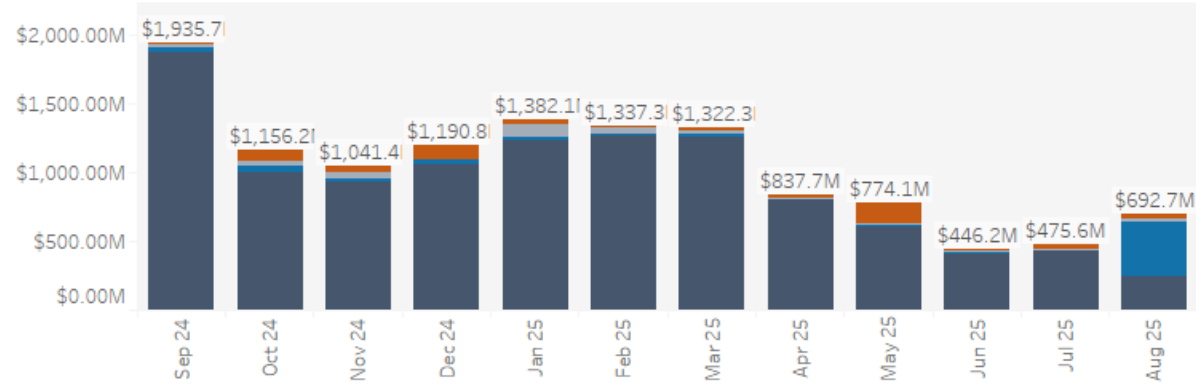
Statewide Letting Information By Fiscal Year (September to August)



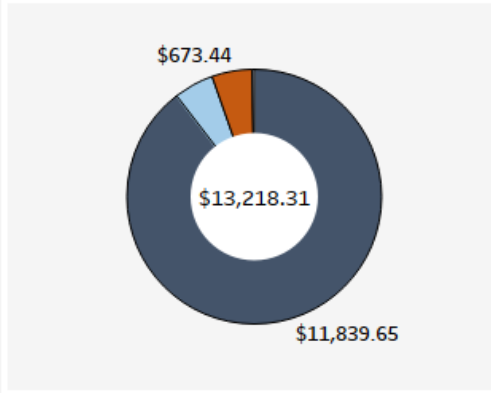

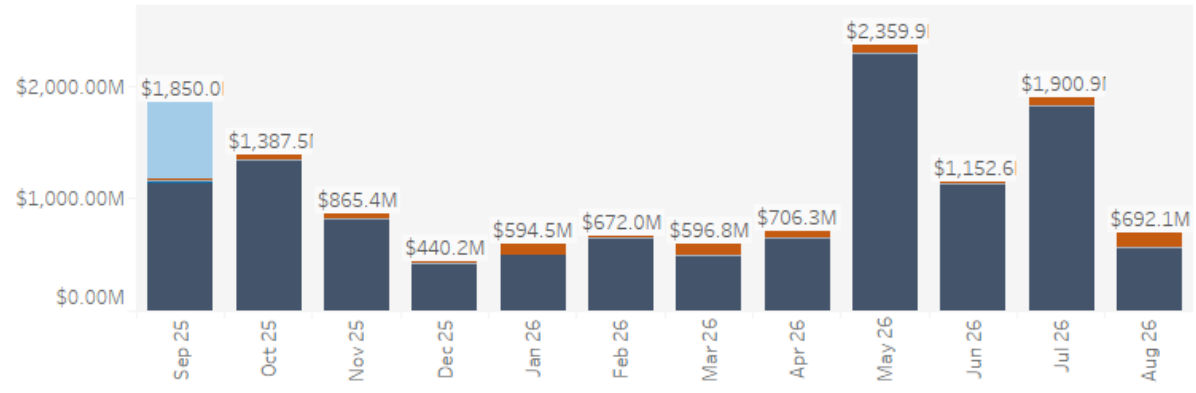


As a prime contractor: How to bid?

- Contractor prequalification:
 - TxDOT must qualify bidders to become eligible to bid or to receive a bid proposal on a **Construction** or **Maintenance** project.
 - <https://www.txdot.gov/business/road-bridge-maintenance/contract-letting/contractor-prequalification.html>

- The agency has three levels of qualification, all of which require annual requalification.

Bidders questionnaire	No financial statement is required, but a compiled or reviewed statement can be submitted to increase bidding capacity over \$1 million. The method of calculating bidding capacity with a financial statement can be found on the questionnaire.
